## Reference Guide

### Planting & Care BMPs

- Dig hole 2-3x wider than root ball
- Dig hole as deep as depth of root ball
- Remove 'packaging' of balled & burlapped trees only after positioning in planting hole
- Straighten tree in hole before backfilling
- Step down backfill as you go
- Leave trunk's root flare clear of soil
- Stake tree 12-18" from trunk
- Water tree after planting
- Mulch 2-3" layer but not against trunk

### Post Planting Care

- Remove stakes and tie after one year
- Water 20g week during growing season
- Keep tree well free of weeds and debris
- Maintain 2-3" layer of mulch
